

## **MISD Athletic Training/Insurance Acknowledgement**

1. I hereby authorize and request all my current or prior physicians to disclose, whenever requested to do so, to the athletic training/sports medicine staff (including athletic trainers, medical, orthopedic or other medical specialty consultants), any and all information with respect to any illness or injury, medical history, consultation, prescriptions, or treatments, including medical imaging and copies of all hospital and medical records. I also give my permission for Manor ISD Sports Medicine staff to obtain current copies of all UIL Pre-Participation Physicals from previous schools that I have attended. This release remains valid until revoked in writing. I understand that these records will remain confidential, be maintained in my child's medical file, and will only be shared with people involved in the care of the athlete. A copy shall be considered as valid as the original. This release allows open communication between doctors and the sports medicine staff.

2. Doctor and Parent Notes: If your child goes to do the doctor for any reason, he/she MUST bring a note from the doctor to the Athletic Trainers. The note must say whether or not they can participate. If the athlete does not bring a note, the athletic trainers will reserve the right to deny participation to the athlete until the note is provided. The athletic trainers are employed by the district to determine whether it is safe for an athlete to participate, and are trained to make those decisions. If you have a concern about your child's health/injury, please contact the athletic trainers.

3. Manor ISD Concussion Policy: Any athlete suspected of having a concussion must be immediately removed from participation and MUST be seen by a physician for diagnosis per HB 2038 and UIL protocol. Before participation, an athlete must receive a clearance note from a physician and complete the Manor ISD return-to-play protocol. All forms must be on file with the Sports Medicine staff. In addition to athletic restrictions, the athlete may also be placed on academic accommodations during this time as well.

4. I hereby authorize the Manor ISD Athletic Trainers to administer to my minor child over the counter medication according to the directions contained on the medications original label.

5. Manor ISD provides a supplemental secondary insurance policy for injuries that are received as a result of athletic competition. You must file on your primary insurance first and the school insurance will act after the primary insurance has paid. This policy is not meant to be the athlete's primary policy and has limited benefits when no primary insurance exists. Charges for treatment of injuries and illnesses shall not be charged to Manor ISD. The Manor ISD provided policy may not pay 100% of the cost of injuries not paid by your insurance carrier. You are responsible for all costs not covered by your insurance or the insurance provided. Manor ISD will not be responsible for medical or other costs related to injuries received by the participant except to provide the insurance coverage outlined.
